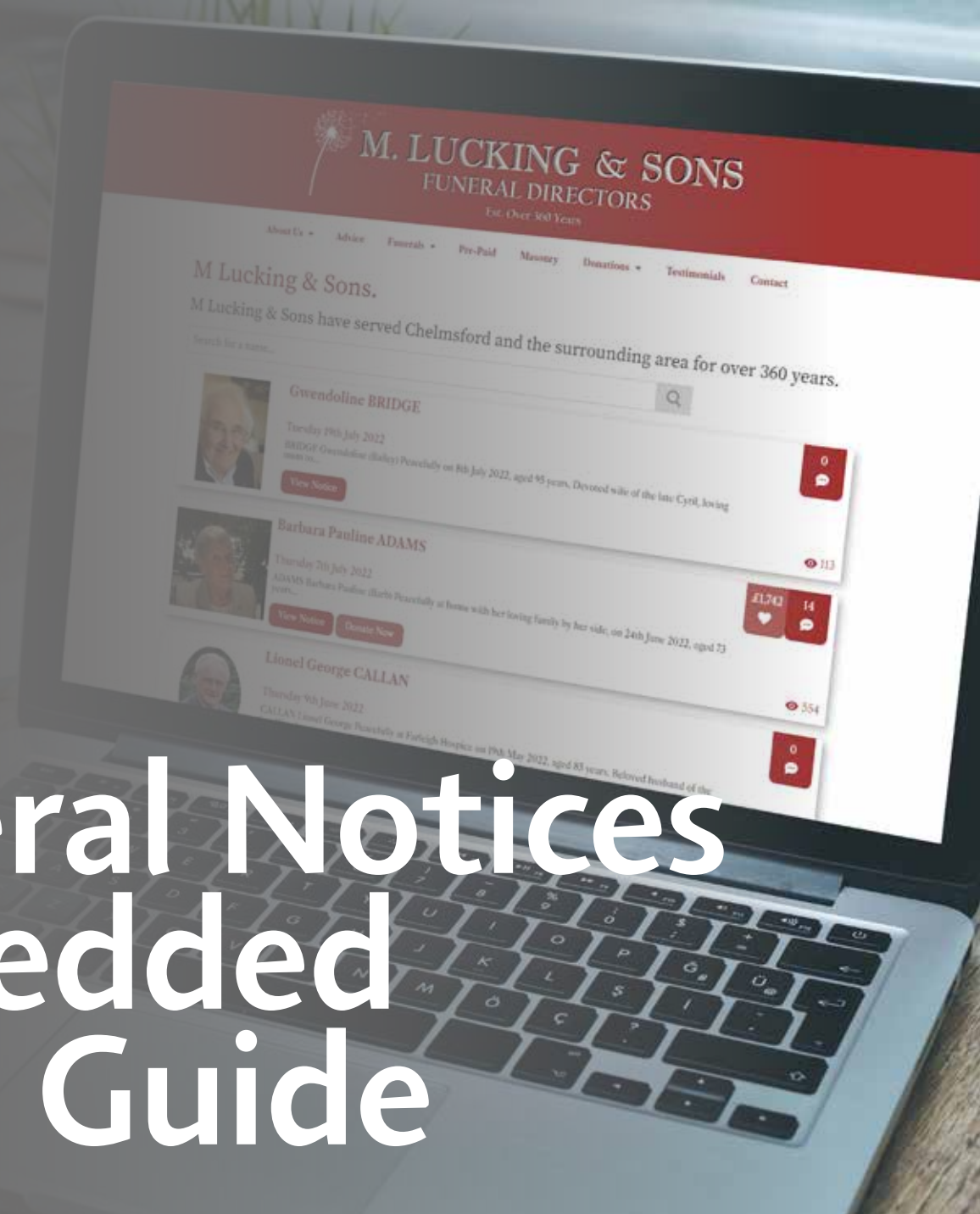
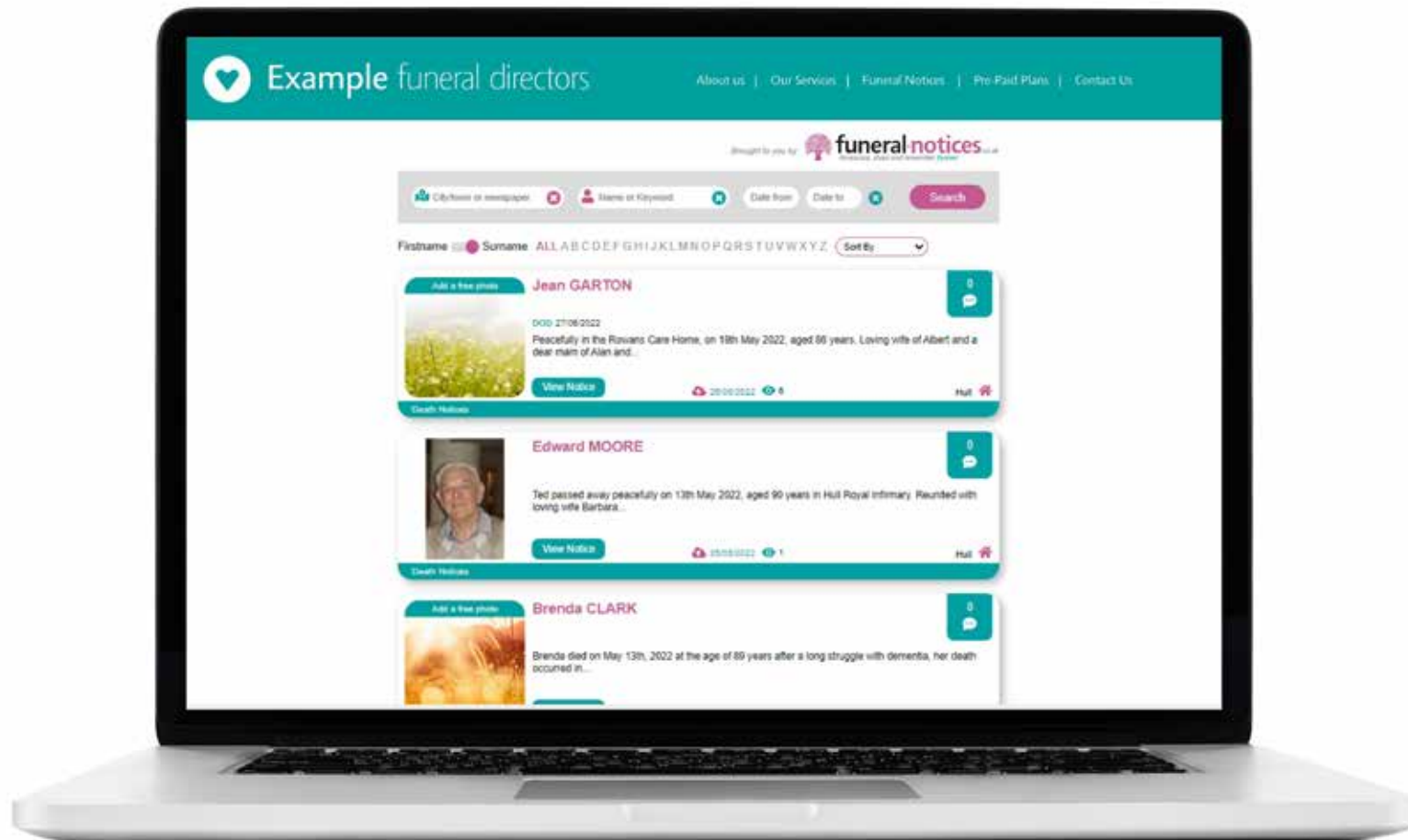


Funeral Notices Embedded Feed Guide

- ✓ A proven way to attract a new pre-need audience to your website.

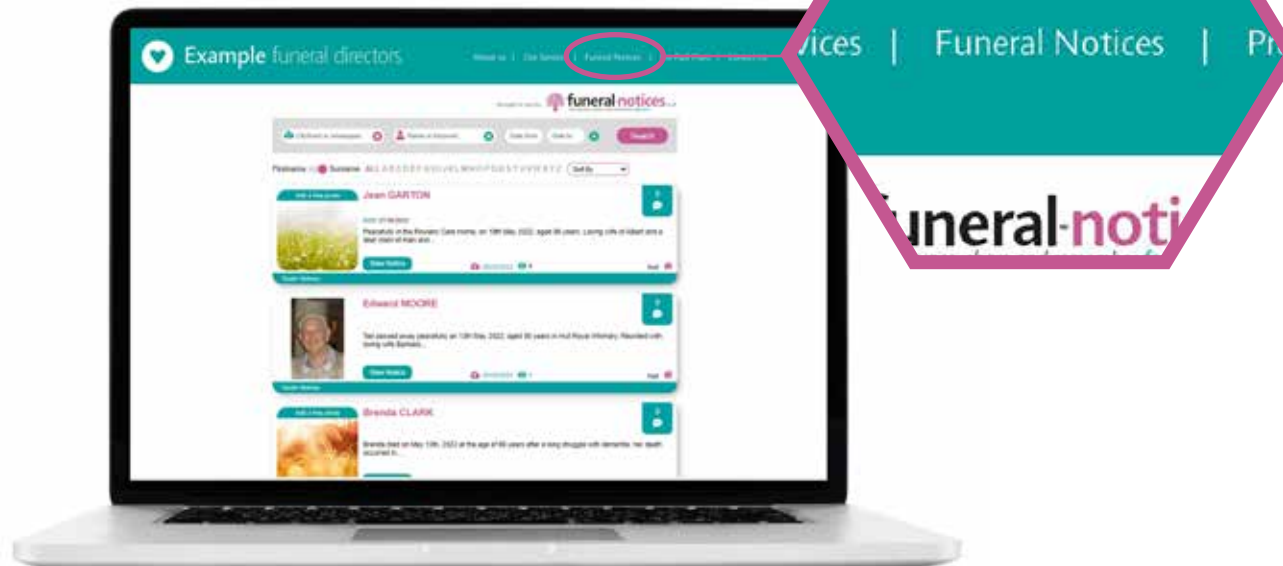


Funeral notices embedded feed best practice

To become an online partner you need to have a link to your new funeral notices embedded feed page on the main navigation menu of your website on both desktop and mobile, ideally not on a drop-down menu as people are less likely to find and interact with it making it harder for the new page to attract new visitors to your website.

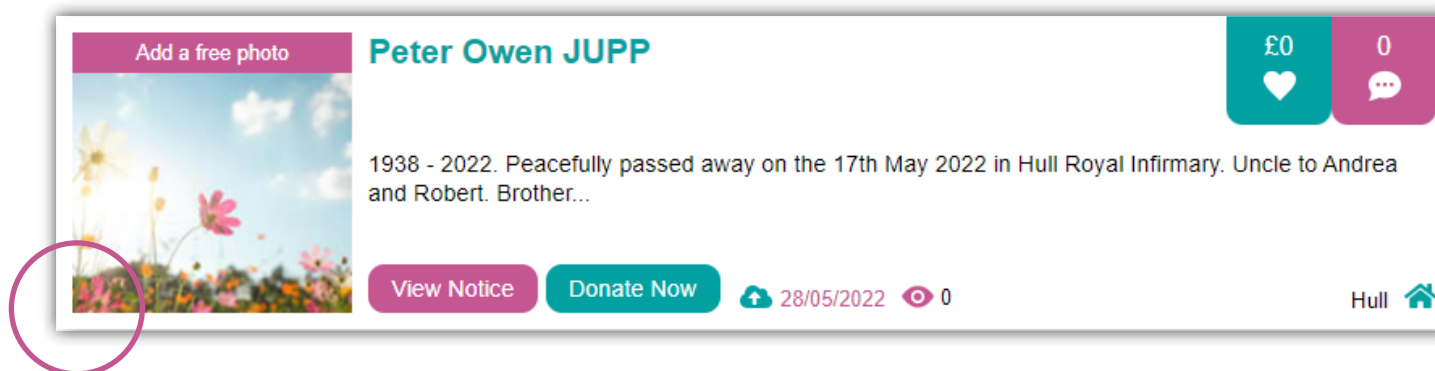

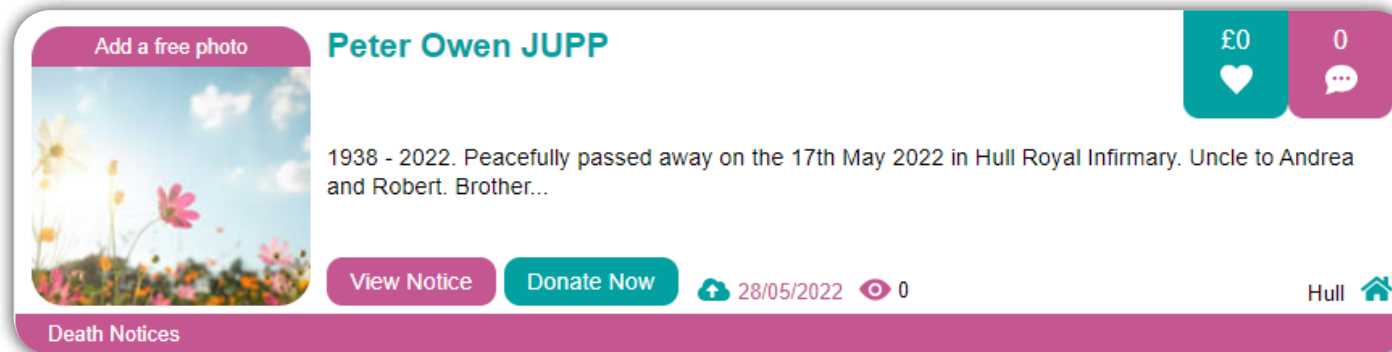

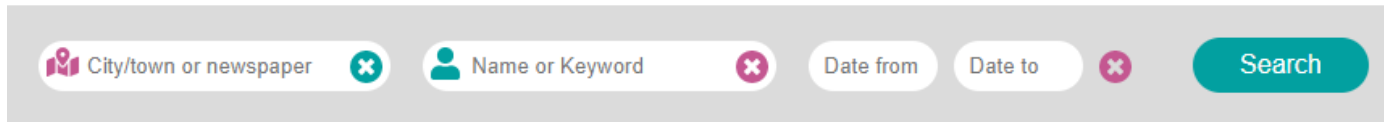

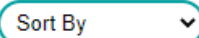

Technical information

Simple installation process explained

Our customisable funeral notices embedded feed has been created so it can be installed on any website that allows HTML coding by someone with very little experience or by an advanced web developer.

We're here to help you every step of the way:

- 1 Decision maker - Choose how you would like your funeral notices embedded feed to look from the options above.
- 2 Funeral Notices Team - Give us your preferences and we will provide you with a unique piece of HTML coding.
- 3 Website administrator - Log in to your website as an admin/developer. Create a blank page on the main navigation bar of your website and choose what to call it. Drop the HTML coding we provided onto the new page.

And that's it, you're now displaying new and historic notices on your website in a style personal to you.

If you are adding the funeral notices embedded feed yourself and need any further advice, don't hesitate to ask as we have a technical team on hand to offer you any advice you might need.
